

## PHILATELIC PERSONALITIES - N. F. SEEBECK

The name of Nicholas F. Seebeck became a byword of the Philatelic World, due to the contracts he made with several South American countries. He agreed to provide them with postage stamps free of charge every year, in return he was to receive any unsold remainders, together with the right to reprint further copies to make up sets as required
